No. O.E.(A)III 49/2012-7179/RDM., In pursuance of Home Department Resolution No.42595/CC., dtd.10.10.2011, applications are invited from the retired ASOs/ SOs of Secretariat for their engagement on contractual basis in Revenue & Disaster Management Department against the vacant post of A.S.O. under the following terms & Conditions by 15.03.2012.

- (i) The retired ASOs/SOs must not be above the age of 62 years. He/She had good service records and is physically fit to discharge the Government duty.
- (ii) The retired ASOs/SOs against whom vigilance case/Departmental Proceedings/Criminal prosecution is completed or pending or who has been penalised for misconduct during the period of ten years preceding his/her retirement will not be considered for re-engagement.
- (iii) The retired ASOs/SOs who has been a member of any political party after his/her retirement shall not be eligible for re-engagement.
- (iv) The appointee has to discharge the duties as prescribed by this Department from time to time.
- (v) Performance of the appointee shall be monitored rigorously by the Department against the monthly targets assigned to him.
- (vi) The contractual engagement will be made for a period of one year .
- (vii) Consolidated remuneration of the contractual employees shall be at the rate of his/her last pay + Grade Pay drawn minus the amount of Pension sanctioned per month.
- (viii) During the period of the contractual appointment, appointee shall also be entitled to get travelling allowance for approved tours at the rate he/she was entitled for at the time of his/her retirement.
- (ix) The period of contractual engagement shall not be counted as Government Service for the purpose of pension or any other retirement benefits.
- (x) The contractual engagement may be terminated at any time by the Department for unsatisfactory performance, on notice of one month and in case of any misconduct including, but not limited to misappropriation, negligence or causing loss to government without any prior notice.
