Sub:- Engagement of Retired Employees like RIs/ ARIs/ Amins- Instructions regarding.


Sir,

I am directed to say that in almost all the districts, there has been shortage of Revenue Field Officers like RIs/ ARIs/ and Amins hampering optimal delivery of public services. In order to address the issue, Government have been pleased to engage the retired RIs/ARIs/Amins with a consolidated remuneration of Rs.9300/-(Rupees Nine thousand & three hundred) only per month. The expenditure in this connection will be met out of the User fees available with the Tahasils.

The Retired Personnel shall have to be engaged in a transparent manner and their services be utilised for a period of 04(four) months for disposal of pending Revenue works, completion of map correction, demarcation, distribution of FRA pattas etc.

The said instruction is to be followed scrupulously.




