Sub: Regarding Inter-district transfer of employees

Madam/Sir,

Inviting a reference to this Deptt. letter No.48737 dtd-20.12.2013 on the subject cited above (copy enclosed), I am directed to say that you were requested in the letter under reference to submit the deputation/ transfer proposal of Class-III and IV employees(District Cadre) to Government for consideration. But, after due examination, it was found to be inconsistent with the relevant Government Resolution/guidelines.

Therefore, it is hereby clarified that henceforth, all representations /proposals for inter-district transfer of district cadre ministerial staff are to be dealt at the level of Board of Revenue/ IGR,Odisha/RDCs/ DLRS&C following due procedure as prescribed in erstwhile G.A Deptt.(now G.A &PG. Deptt.) resolution no.28949 dated 15.7.1992 and Resolution dated 26th of August 1993. Similarly, for Revenue Supervisor/Revenue Inspector/Assistant Revenue

Inspector/Amin the matter will be dealt with reference to ODRS Rules,1983 and this Deptt. notification No.27231 dated 24.6.1996.

The R & DM Letter No. RDM-NGEB-POLICY-0015-2013-48737 dated the 20th of December,2013 is hereby withdrawn.
