Induction Training of 1st batch taking 56 nos. of ORS Officers shall be conducted during April, 2016. The 2nd batch Induction Training taking another 56 ORS Officers shall be conducted after completion of the 1st batch Training and so on. The 2nd and 3nd batch Officers shall undergo District Training under the control of the Collector concerned for 23 days (4 weeks) in the Districts they have been posted.
