

Sub: Availability of Internet connectivity for RI offices from Broadband services provided by BSNL to all GPs under Bharat Net Project


Madam/Sir,





Minutes of the meeting held on 03.05.2017 at 11.30 A.M in Revenue and DM Department Conference Hall under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary on issues relating to provision of Infrastructure and IT Infrastructure to R.I Offices of the State.

A meeting was held on 03.05.2017 at 11.30 A.M in Revenue Department Conference Hall under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary to discuss the issues relating to provision of Infrastructure and IT Infrastructure to R.I Offices of the State.

At the outset, Principal Secretary emphasized on the provision of basic amenities and infrastructure in RI Offices of the State for delivery of the notified Government to Citizen (G2C) public services. After a threadbare discussion on the sanctioned post of RIs, ARIs, Amins, the vacancy, position, provision of building for RI Offices with basic amenities and provision of IT infrastructure in RI Offices, the following decisions were taken :-

1. **Filling of posts of RIs/ARIs/Amins:** It was decided that Collectors would be requested to file requisition before the Odisha Sub-ordinate Staff Selection Commission to fill up the posts for 344 RIs, 445 ARIs and 1192 Amins lying vacant in the State. In this regard instruction has already been issued from this department vide letter no. 17940 dated 19.06.2015.

(Action: NGE(B) Branch)

2. **Strengthening of Infrastructure in RI Offices of the State:** Principal Secretary, R&DM Deptt. insisted on strengthening infrastructure in RI Offices of the State. It was decided to collect the information on building provision of RI Offices along with basic amenities like electricity connection, drinking water facility and sanitation facility and the estimated budgetary provision to meet the expenditure. For this NIC personnel were requested to develop a small web based application where Tahasildars will submit information online. After collecting information a meeting shall be convened in the Department which Chief Engineer (Buildings) / Chief Engineer (RW-I) shall be invited.

(Action- REM Branch)

3. **Operationalization status of supplied Laptops to R.I Offices:** During the year 2013-14, around 1790 Laptops, Scanners and Printers were supplied to the RI offices by OCAC under e-District project. It was ascertained that some of the Revenue Inspectors are not using the hardwares for official work due to lack of connectivity. Many of the laptops are also not functioning. Principal Secretary instructed to collect the operational status report of laptops supplied to RI Offices to explore the possibility of providing connectivity to RIs from the user fee available in Tahasils.

(Action- IMU Cell)

4. The scope of expenditure under user fee shall be examined and a revised guidelines for utilization of user fee may be notified following due procedure in which purchase of hardware, provision of connectivity and AMC for the hardware may be included.

(Action: CHS Branch)

5. In order to monitor the implementation of various e-Governance programmes and the delivery of notified public services to the citizens, it is required to post regular manpower in the department having adequate knowledge and experience in e-Governance.

(Action: OE-A Branch)

6. **Provision of furniture and fixtures in R.I Offices:** It was decided that necessary furniture and fixture will be provided to all the R.I Offices during the financial year 2017-18. All districts will be requested to submit their proposal for required furniture and fixtures R.I Circle wise.

(Action: REM Branch)

7. **Refresher Training for the Revenue Inspectors and Budgetary Provision:** At present different web based application like e-District, online mutation software (LRMS) etc. are being used for delivery of public services in which Revenue Inspectors play a major role of submitting enquiry report online and disposal of mutation cases. Principal Secretary instructed to train the RIs on the information technology, use of software and the recent acts, rules etc for 3 (three) days in the Revenue Instructor Training Institute.

(Action: NGE(B) Branch)

8. Instructions to be issued to all Collectors to avail the internet connectivity for RI office from broadband services provided by BSNL to all GPs under BharatNet project. In this regard, the notification issued by E&IT Department vide no. 276/E&IT dated 18.01.2017 will also be shared with Collectors.

(Action: DILRMP Cell)

9. The expenditure to be incurred for providing connectivity to RI offices may be met from the user fee available in tahasils.

(Action: DILRMP Cell)

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair and all participants.

NOTIFICATION

The BhratNet project (erstwhile NOFN project) is a National Project with an objective to provide high speed Broadband services to all Gram Panchayats. The BhratNet phase-I project is being implemented by Bharat Broadband Nigam Ltd. (BBNL) The Broadband connections are being provided to the GPs in a progressive manner. The high speed Broadband of 100 Mbps at GPs level through the BhartNet project shall be very much useful for accessing Internet, online applications, applications under various Government schemes, etc. The BBNL has conveyed a special tariff plan for State Government Agencies/ Institutions for availing the Broadband services. The Government after careful consideration have approved the following for effective utilization of the Broadband infrastructure.

1. Individual Department at GP level may apply to BSNL for internet connection under three plans at present namely GP-699, GP-999 and GP-1499 in terms of letter No.53-7/215-NOFN-Ops dated 27.04.2016 of GM (NOFN), BSNL, Corporate Office, New Delhi. It is suggested that Plan GP 699 may be taken by the user Departments initially as the monthly charges are the lowest among the plan. Further, on modification of tariff plan by BBNL/BSNL in future, the new tariff plans shall be applicable.
2. The Broadband service can be subscribed by Gram Panchayat (GP) office and other Government institutions at the GP level belonging to other Departments. The applications may be made to BSNL for obtaining the Broadband service and the monthly charge under the selected plan may be paid by the offices of respective Departments.
3. The CSC working in Rajiv Gandhi Seva kendra may be encouraged to avail the Broadband services and these centres may be treated as agencies of Government to avail concessional charges.
4. The respective Departments may be advised to issue suitable instructions to their field level offices at GPs to avail the Broadband services at Block and GPs level.






