Sub: Package for relocating the villagers of Satabhaya and Kanhupur in Bagapatia

Sir,

In continuation to this Department Letter No. 45260/R&D.M. dated 6.11.2010 on the above mentioned subject, I am directed to say that in order to give an opportunity to the families living in Satabhaya and Kanhupur villages of Kendrapara District to shift to a safe site at Bagapatia under Rajnagar Tahasil in view of the threat perception on account of their close proximity to sea, Government have been pleased to approve the following package:

Resettlement Assistance

1. Each household (Original family) will be provided with up to 1/10th of an acre of homestead land at the relocation site. Patta should be issued in the name of both the spouses, if surviving.
2. Each original family will be granted a dwelling house under IAY/ Mo Kudia. The required number of IAY houses will be allotted from the admissible quota for calamity related housing provision at the State Level under IAY. In case any family is not eligible to avail IAY house/ Mo

Kudia out of normal allocation, a special allocation under Mo Kudia may be proposed.

Provision of basic facilities and amenities

1. Electrification of the proposed households will be taken up under RGGVY.
2. Required number of hand pump tube wells will be installed in the resettlement colony by RWSS Wing of R.D. Department for providing potable drinking water.
3. Required number of Primary Schools will be provided to the resettlement colony by OPEPA.
4. Construction of approach road and road inside the resettlement colony will be provided under the ongoing MGNREGS, PMGSY and Block Concrete Road Programmes.
5. Strengthening of protection embankment will be taken up by DoWR from the resources available at their disposal.

Government have also been pleased to authorize the concerned line Departments to use the available resources under ongoing programmes for implementing the relocation plan and Revenue & D.M. Department has been allowed to make budget provision for land acquisition and residual requirements that cannot be met under the ongoing programmes.


Action should be taken accordingly for relocating the villagers of the said villages.
