Sub:- Settlement of Sairat sources (Minor Minerals) for an area of less than 05 hectares on the basis of long term lease.

Sir,

It has been reported by various agencies / institutions that due to non-availability of minor minerals like ordinary sand, stone, moorum, boulders, etc. owing to delay caused in settlement of sairat sources of less than 5.00 hectares existing in different districts, developments projects like roads, buildings etc. have suffered on the ground Government have noted the above matter with concern along with the slow pace of disposal of applications for environmental clearance by the competent authority i.e. SEIAA in respect of sairat sources of less than 5 (five) hectares.

After careful consideration, it has been decided, that sairat sources under the control of this Department may also be settled by grant of quarry leases as contained in Chapter-IV of OMMC Rules, 2004 which is one of the appropriate methods of settlement of sairat sources. The sairat sources may be disposed on long term basis up to 5 (five) years in pursuance of provisions contained in Rule-26 to 29 of Chapter-IV of the aforesaid Rules.

Therefore, you are requested that suitable instructions may please be issued to all concerned for settlement of sairat sources including long term lease up to of 5 (five) years as per the provisions laid down in Chapter-IV under the title "Grant of quarry leases" of OMMC Rules, 2004.
