Reforming Public Service Delivery System in

Odisha: waiver of affidavits and adoption of self –attestation of documents in the process to grant Miscellaneous Certificates

Sir,

With a view to improve delivery of services to the Citizens of the State by simplifying the procedure, after careful consideration, Government have been pleased to waive out the requirement of affidavits in the process to grant various Miscellaneous Certificates under the Odisha Miscellaneous Certificate Rules, 1984 except Solvency Certificate and adoption of self-attestation of documents.

Affidavits are basically affirmation of facts given by the applicants for issue of various Certificates. The purpose for which affidavits are being sought can be met by declarations. Affidavit is a declaration, and as such, a self declaration in itself is adequate for the purpose. Therefore, the requirement of affidavits in Odisha Miscellaneous Rules, 1984, is as such being met by the Self – Declaration of the applicant which is there in Form No.1 of the Odisha Miscellaneous Certificate Rules, 1984. However, with a view to make its implications more explicit to all concerned, the said declaration appearing at point no. 9 of Form no. 1 of the Odisha Miscellaneous Certificate Rules, 1984 is hereby modified as below:

That, I am solely responsible for the accuracy of the declaration and information furnished and liable for action under section 199 and 200 of the Indian Penal Code in case of wrong declaration and information. Also, I am well aware of the fact that the certificate shall be summarily cancelled and all the benefits availed by me shall be summarily withdrawn in case of wrong declaration and information."

Applications for Miscellaneous Certificates with self-attested documents shall be accepted. However, at the time of final decision, the officer competent to issue Miscellaneous Certificate may verify the original documents.

All the concerned field level Revenue Officers may be instructed to immediately act in accordance with the revised procedure and implementation of these revised guidelines be ensured.
