Sub: Clarification regarding remittance of establishment charges into Government account and its retention with Collector/ Spl. L.A.O.

I am directed to invite a reference to your letter No. 71 dtd. 18.07.2017 on the subject noted above and to say that as per the Accounting procedure, the R.O shall deposit towards the Administrative cost /LA Contingency @ 20 % of estimated compensation amount, which will be shared as below:-

15% - to be remitted to Government treasury

4.25%- to be retained in Bank A/C of Collector /Sp. L.A.O

0.25%- to be transferred to R&DM Deptt.

0.5%- to be transferred to RDC.

If the land is acquired by IDCO, then IDCO shall take 50% (10% out of 20% given by RO) and out of the balance amount, 50% (5% out of 10%) will be deposited with the Government treasury and the rest will be shared as above.

In the new Odisha RFCTLAR&R Rules, 2016 at Rule 24 (2),it is provided that 50% of the amount deposited by the R.O. will be deposited to the Government treasury. This provision is at par with the provisions when the land is acquired through IDCO. However, in case of direct acquisition of land by government (without involving IDCO) for any R.O, 75% is deposited to the Treasury. Earlier circulars on accounting procedure for Acquisition of private Land were issued from time to time after concurrence of the Finance Department and the same practice as per the existing Accounting Procedure is continuing in the State.

After careful consideration Government have been pleased to decide to continue the same practice as per the existing Accounting Procedure for the land acquisition cases under RFCTLAR & R Act 2013 until further orders...
