ORDER

Sub- Remission of cess payable in respect of all villages which have sustained crop loss due to drought condition during kharif 2015.

Due to acute shortage of rainfall in the State during Monsoon 2015, Kharif crops in many parts of the State have suffered severe moisture stress adversely affecting the farmers. The Government in Revenue and Disaster Management Department (Special Relief), in pursuance of the provision contained in Para-29(b) of the Odisha Relief Code, have declared as per 139 blocks in 21 Districts as drought affected vide Notification No.4519 dated 07.11.2015. The Government have also declared packages to provide assistance to affected farmers.

Keeping in view the sustained crop loss due to severe drought condition, the Government, after careful consideration have been pleased to direct under section 10-A of the Orissa Cess Act, 1962 as follows:

- 1. 50% remission in respect of cess on land revenue for the current financial year will be given to farmers where the crop loss is 33% or more.
- 2. Collection of the remaining amount will be deferred to the next financial year without any interest.

This will be applicable to the areas as notified by Government in the above Notification and in such other areas, as will be notified by Government pertaining to drought 2015.
