**Sub: Successful implementation different e-Governance initiatives of Revenue & DM Department such as e-Mutation, Revenue Court Case Monitoring System (RCCMS), e-Registration, Bhunaksha application for digital map correction, online MTA application for rent collection etc.**

Madam/ Sir,

In inviting references to this Department earlier letters on the subject cited above, I am to say that Revenue Department has taken various steps towards making revenue administration transparent and more citizen centric by introducing various e-Governance initiatives such as e-Mutation, Revenue Court Case Monitoring System (RCCMS), e-Registration, Bhunaksha application for digital map correction, online MTA application for rent collection etc. following Hon'ble Chief Minister's vision of 3 T's i.e. Technology, Transparency and Team work for good Governance.

Further, to fix accountability of revenue field functionaries and officers 25-point parameters and ORTPS daily bulletin has been linked in the Department's website.

It may be recollected that training to all Tahsildars and Additional Tahsildars were given RDC wise separately at ROTI by NIC and it was decided that they would be the master trainers of the Bhunaksha for imparting training to RIs and Amins at their respective Tahsils.

Further, it was decided to adopt point distance measurement method for digital correction of maps. A district wise implementation plan along with the user manual of Bhunaksha having step by step procedure for map correction was communicated vide this Department letter no. 24716 dated. 06.07.2018. To become familiar with Bhunaksha application software one testing URL having user ID and password was also communicated vide the same letter.

It was also intimated that 100 nos. of Tahsils which have completed more than 80% cadastral map correction/ updation will start implementing Bhunaksha scheduled from 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2018 and all remaining Tahasils will complete cadastral map correction/ updation by 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2018 and adopt the Bhunaksha application from 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2018 as per the district wise schedule plan communicated earlier.

Keeping the above said points in mind the Government have been pleased to approve that-

1. Irrespective of the date of institution of mutation case, if its disposal is on or after 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2018 the textual Record of Right (RoR) must mandatorily be corrected/ made/ created along with correction of cadastral map through Bhunaksha application software. It means no Record of Right (RoR) can be corrected/ made/ created without the correction of cadastral map through Bhunaksha application software from 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2018. No case will be considered as disposed if corresponding map correction in Bhunaksha application software is not done. That means the Spatial RoR is to be sync with the Textual RoR.
2. Disposal of all Revenue cases such as OLR8A, OLR 19(1)(C), OPLE, OGLS, Bebandobasta, Demarcation etc. to be made mandatory on RCCMS, so that Daily Bulletin on disposal of Revenue Cases can be correctly generated.
3. If any of the officers found to be disposing cases otherwise, disciplinary action may be initiated against such officers.
4. ADM, Sub-Collectors to ensure the observance of the guideline by strict supervision.

You are, therefore, requested to instruct all ADMs, Sub-Collectors and Tahsildars accordingly for success of different e-Governance programmes of the state administration.
