Sub: Regarding Amendment to Rule-87 of the Manual of Tahasil Accounts.

Sir,

In inviting a reference to your letter No. 2136 Dt-09.08.2016 on the above noted subject I am directed to say that Government in Revenue and Disaster Management Department have been pleased to approve the necessary amendment to rule 87 of the "Manual of Tahasil Accounts" as follows:

Rule 87 of the Manual of Tahasil Accounts shall be renumbered as sub-rule (1) thereof and after the sub-rule (1) as so renumbered, the following sub-rules shall be inserted namely:-


"(2) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, the Tahasildar and the Revenue Inspector may make remittance to the Cyber Treasury either through online or offline payment process and such remittance shall be accounted and reported by the Cyber Treasury".

"(3) Any person who desires to make e-payment of any Government revenue, on account of conversion fee, royalty for minor minerals, and such other Government revenue as may be declared by the State Government, may also remit such amount using the online or offline facility of Cyber Treasury".

This has been concurred by the Finance Department vide their U.O.R No-447/SS Dt-07.10.2016.

You are, therefore, requested to take further action in the matter and issue necessary correction slip for amendment to rule 87 of the Manual of Tahasil Accounts at your end.


