Sub- Detection of cases U/s 19 (1) (c) of OLR Act and to start suo-motto cases Madam/Sir,

In inviting reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to say that while reviewing the performance of the disposal cases U/s 19 (1) c of the OLR Act 1960 for the month of October 2017, Principal Secretary expressed his displeasure regarding poor disposal of cases U/s 19 (1) c of the OLR Act 1960. As a result of which large no. of cases remained undetected by the Revenue Officer U/s 19 (1) c of the OLR Act 1960, which affect to land Revenue collection in the State. Since in many Tahasils in Odisha, RORs were prepared and issued to concerned land owner in last settlement which was conducted in 1970s & 80s and there was no further revision settlement, many cases remain un-partitioned & thereafter dispute arises in families for non division of land share and collection of revenue in full by RI is hampered . .

You are therefore, requested to look into the matter personally and issue necessary instruction to Tahasildars for detection of cases under 19(1)c of OLR Act by R.Is and to start suo-motto cases for quick disposal for fruitful result, enhancing augmentation of revenue collection and resolving disputes.

This may be accorded as MOST URGENT.
