**Sub: - Continuation of Central Sector Scheme DILRMP beyond March, 2017 and sanction of funds regarding.**

**Ref: Your Department letter No. F.N. 18014/02/2014-LRD dated 12.07.2018, dated 27.07.2018, This Department letter No. 33253 dated 04.09.2018, No. 33326 dated 04.09.2018, No. 32646 dated. 31.08.2018**

Sir,

1. In continuation to referenced letters of your Department and this Department on the subject noted above, I am to say that in the Regional Review Conference of DILRMP held on 06th September, 2018 at Agartala, Tripura the Annual Action Plan for the FY-2018-19 for DILRMP in the State of Odisha was discussed.
2. As per the Annual Action Plan so discussed an amount of Rs. 63.7372 crores in the financial year 2018-19 and Rs. 193.7220 crores in the FY 2019-20 is required. (excluding the component "Survey/Resurvey").
3. In the draft operational guidelines of DILRMP, as communicated in the Regional Conference at Agartala, it is stated that - *A mobilization of advance up to 30% will be released as first installment to the States/UTs based on their approved annual action plan. subsequent installments (Out of remaining amount) will be released on reimbursement basis on the basis of entry of bills/vouchers by vendor on completion of different milestones of work which are entered in the Expenditure Advance Transfer (EAT) module of the Public Finance Management System (PFMS). All sanctions will be done on the basis of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs), which will be part of annual action plan prepared by States/UTs in the prescribed Proforma.*
4. It is pertinent to mention here that DILRMP has been made a 100% central sponsored scheme in 2016. But, since, 2013-14 no funds have been allocated to the State of Odisha. Hence, the progress of other components of DILRMP has been hampered.

5. It is, therefore, requested that instead of mobilization of advance up to 30% will be released as first installment to the State and subsequent release on reimbursement basis, 100% of the approved amount may be released for the FY-2018-19 in advance. There should be no proposal of reimbursement as the entire scheme is 100% centrally sponsored. Further, the funds may be availed through PFMS so that the entry of expenditure may be made immediately.




