NOTIFICATION

In pursuance of R&DM Department Resolution No - 35072/R&DM dtd 13.11.19, the Government in E&IT Department have been pleased to modify this Department Notification No. 2889 Dtd 09.10.13 issued earlier notifying service charges of the Common Service Centres (CSC) operators and District e-Governance Society (DeGS) share for electronic filling, receipt, processing and delivery of certificates/ services under eDistrict Project being implemented in all the 30 districts of Odisha, under the Section 6A of the "The information Technology Amendment Act 2008" in the manner laid down as under:

- i. Under eDistrict Project, the list of Services and service specific statutory Government fees shall be notified by Electronics and Information Technology Department/ Other State Government Departments from time to time.
- ii. In addition to service delivery through CSCs, citizens may also avail online services under eDistrict Project, as to be specified by the respective Departments.
- iii. Apart from statutory Government fees, the DeGS Share wherever applicable shall be paid electronically by the citizens applying directly to avail services at their own convenience, without visiting CSC centers as indicated for services mentioned below, which can be revised from time to time:

- iv. Apart from statutory Government fees, CSC operators shall also collect their Service Charges from the Citizens who wish to avail the below mentioned services by visiting CSC centers as indicated below, which can be revised from time to time.

NB :- <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. The CSC operator has to collect Rs. 10/- from the applicant during the filling of Application and collect the balance Rs.8/- for services stated at Sl. No. 1 above and balance Rs 10/- for services stated at Sl. No. 2 & 3 above at the time of Delivery of Certificate/ document.ii. The Acknowledgement of receipt of Application/ Delivery of Certificate and Payment Received from the Citizen shall be issued free of cost by the CSC Operators to the Citizen.iii. Scanning Fee per page = Rs.3/- at CSCiv. Printing Fee per page = Rs. 5/- at CSCv. No Fees has to be paid by Citizen for filling Grievance (maximum 2 times per service for the service availed through the same (CSC), but for printing acknowledgement if required by citizen for this purpose usual printing charges mentioned at point (iv) will be applicable.vi. The Scanning and Printing charges for attachments shall be collected extra from the Citizen by the CSC operator as mentioned at Point (iii) & point (iv). <p>CSC – Common Service Centre (Jana Seva Kendra) DeGS – District eGovernance Society</p>			

- The Scanning and Printing charges for attachments shall be collected extra from the applicant by the CSC Operator / VLE as indicated above.

- The CSC Operator/ VLE will deposit the Statutory Government Fees in the respective Tahasils / Concerned Offices and DeGS share at respective Collectorates as may be communicated by Electronics & Information Technology Department/ Other State Government Departments from time to time.
