Sub- Online Payment of Land Revenue

Sir,

I am to say that the Govt. have decided to allow the citizens/ tenants to pay the land revenue dues online in a phased manner for which NIC has developed the application software. This arrangement will be in addition to the existing arrangement of payment of land revenue.

In this connection, I am further to say that discussions have been taken up with Department of Finance, Directorate of Treasuries along with NIC to fine tune payment mechanism and its integration into e-payment gateway, so that the interface is simple flawless and citizen-friendly. We have also requested IIIT, Bhubaneswar to take up Cyber Security Audit and the same is in progress .A set of detailed guidelines will be issued shortly. However, for immediate reference brief instructions are enclosed with this letter. The Tenant's Ledger (TL) Entry has been completed more than 80 percent in respect of **Dhenkanal, Kandhamal, Anugul, Nabarangpur, Rayagada, Nayagarh, Deogarh, Boudh, Sonepur and Bhadrak** . Hence, facilities for online payment will commence in **first week of December** in these districts. The entry of remaining entries should be ensured before this, after which other districts will be taken up.

You are, advised to be in readiness .Those districts who are lagging behind in TL entry should update 100% entry within a fortnight, so that online payment will be fully operational in all districts w.e.f. **01.01.2019**.

BRIEF PROCEDURE

1. Tenant Ledger (TL) module of Manual of Tahasil Account (MTA) has been developed by NIC and soon Cyber Security Audit of the application will also be completed.
2. Citizens can ascertain their demand and pay rent online over Bhulekh portal by selecting their land details (<http://www.bhulekh.ori.nic.in>).
3. The application software was also integrated with Odisha Treasury Portal (IFMS) to facilitate online payment of Rent and Cess.
4. After making the payment over the portal, they will get the acknowledgement of their payment.
5. Once the money is being credited in Government Account, they can download the rent receipt from Bhulekh website.
6. Tahasildars and RIs can also generate MIS report pertaining to online payment over this portal to ascertain their Revenue Collection Target.
