**Sub : Disposal of Mutation Cases by Revenue Inspectors.**

**Ref : Revenue Department's letter No.34653 dated 1.9.2004 and letter No.537/DE. dated 25.5.2004 of Board of Revenue.**

Sir/ Madam,

The modalities of disposal of Mutation Cases by the Revenue Inspectors were vividly described in the above two correspondences. Despite this, it is observed that the strategy has not achieved the desired result, as proper attention has not been given to the implementation of the guidelines enumerated in the circular of Board of Revenue and instructions of the Government.

It is reiterated once again that all Mutation Cases initiated at the level of the Tahasil on receipt of Form No.III or otherwise should immediately be transferred to the concerned Revenue Inspector for disposal. In course of enquiry and disposal by the Revenue Inspector, if it comes to his notice that a particular case turns out to be a contested one, he should transmit back such case to the Tahasildar for disposal. Thus, large number of cases can be disposed of at the level of Revenue Inspector which will accelerate the pace of disposal of Mutation Cases which is now very important as we are going to issue Land Pass Books to all the land holding families of the State. Necessary instructions should be issued to the Tahasildars accordingly and the disposal of Mutation Cases be closely monitored at your level regularly and a report be submitted to this Department every month.
