**Sub. : Regarding issue of Caste Certificate.**

Madam/Sir,

It has been brought to the notice of the Government that the some natural children whose father or forefathers have been issued ST or SC Certificates are not being issued caste certificate by the Tahasildars. After careful consideration, the Govt. have been pleased to decide that the caste certificate may be issued to natural children whose father and forefathers have been issued such caste certificates subject to verification of revenue records and local enquiry in accordance with the Rule 5 of Odisha Caste Certificate (for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Rules, 1980). At the same time, the Tahasildar may refer to decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case of Kumari Madhuri Patil-vrs-Addl. Commissioner, reported in 1995 AIR 94 decided on 02.9.1994.
