Sub: Implementation of online mutation in Jatni Tahasil.

Sir,

In inviting reference to the subject cited above, I am desired to say that Dr. Usharani Sahoo, Joint Secretary to Govt., R&DM Department visited Jatani Tahasil on 06.02.2018 along with Sub-Collector, Bhubaneswar, Senior Technical Director, NIC, Project Head, e-Registration, SDE, BSNL and DIO, NIC, Khordha. From the feedback, I found the following actionable points which need your personal intervention for quick disposal of mutation cases in Jatni Tahasil through online mutation software (LRMS).

Action points for Tahasildar, Jatni

- 1. The backlog entry in 4675 cases [both mutation & OLR 8(A)] is to be completed by 15th March, 2018.
- 2. Out of 1685 online mutation cases pending, maximum number of cases i.e. 793 is pending with Sri Biswajit Mishra, Addl. Tahasildar. 180 cases are pending with OIC, Record Room, 277 pending with RI Jatni and 167 with RI Pradhansahi. Steps shall be taken to dispose the pending cases within 15 days for which the given time limit under ORTPS is over.
- 3. The cases pending at Record Keeper level is to be segregated on the basis of action to be taken. The record verification and final correction of RoR for which appeal period is over are to be done promptly.
- 4. To ensure that there shall not be any proxy setting in the internet browser to get the full speed of MPLS VPN connectivity to LRMS server.
- 5. To take steps to procure the computer and peripherals immediately. Collector, Khordha has approved for purchase of 7 Desktops, 5 printers, 4 scanners & 2 inverters to facilitate the disposal of online mutation cases which was communicated to the Tahasildar, Jatni vide Memo No. 65 dated 01.2.2018.
- 6. To submit proposal for diversion of funds out of user fees from Bhubaneswar Tahasil to Jatni Tahasil for procurement of computers and peripherals to Collector, Khordha through Sub-Collector, Bhubaneswar due to inadequacy of the funds with the Tahasildar, Jatni.

- 7. To verify the detail position of user fees collected and expenditure incurred since the date of collection of user fees as the amount available under this head (about 4.8 lakhs) is quite low as comparison to the potential of the Tahasil. .
- 8. To take immediate steps for obtaining VPN certificate for all RIs of Jatni Tahasil. Proposal to this effect to be submitted to NIC within 2 days.

Action points for NIC, Bhubaneswar

1. To upload the finally published settlement RoRs of villages Belpada & Ogarsuan in the Bhulekh website.

Action points for Project Head, e-Registration

1 To allow the viewing of all registrati
