**NOTIFICATION**

No. RDM-DILRMP-HISURV-0007-2018-7644 /R&DM, dated 14 FEB 2020

The Government have been pleased to decide that after successful completion of training of Licensed Surveyors, they will be granted necessary license by the DLRS at his level. DLRS may send the list of such Licensed Surveyors to the Collectors for use as and when required.

The guidelines for deployment of the Licensed Surveyors are as follows:

1. In case of a Licensed Surveyor is assigned demarcation of private land by the Tahasildar, then user fee amounting to Rs. 800/- per day per application will be collected by the Tahasildar from the applicant out of which Rs.700/- will be paid to Licensed Surveyor as remuneration and Rs. 100/-will be deposited in the Government account under proper head.
2. In case Licensed Surveyor is assigned other works including requisition by other offices and land acquisition etc. which are not related to tenants, the requisitioning organization shall be charged Rs.1000/- per application, per day out of which Rs.900/- per day will be paid to the Licensed Surveyor and Rs.100/- will be deposited in the Government treasury under proper Head of Account.
3. If the total area of demarcation exceeds Ac.5.00, then the Tahasildar shall charge Rs.200/- additionally per acre, out of which Rs.180/- will be paid to Licensed Surveyor as remuneration and Rs. 20/- will be deposited in the Government account.
4. Application fee for demarcation will be governed by the rate fixed by the Government from time to time.
5. The duties of the Licensed Surveyors will be governed by OSS &S Act, 2012 and Rules made there under.
6. These guidelines will not apply to demarcation taken up by Govt. Amins.

The Director, Land Records and Survey may prepare further technical guidelines as deemed proper.
