



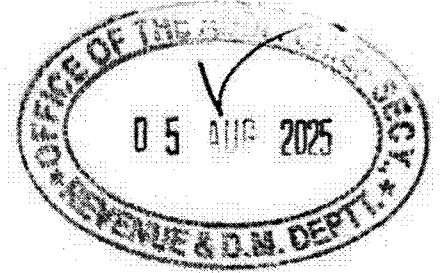

Sub: Data for effective monitoring and proactive decision-making

Madam/Sir

A Chief Minister's Dashboard is being developed by Odisha Computer Application Centre (OCAC) as an advanced digital platform designed to facilitate real-time, data-driven governance, enabling people centric administration via monitoring and analysis of the various Departments within the state government.

The Chief Minister's Dashboard (hereinafter referred to as "the Dashboard") will act as a comprehensive platform to view the real-time status of government schemes and programs, accessing data and analytics, enabling data informed proactive decision-making. This will also enable Government Departments to view, monitor and take timely decisions.

A. The Dashboard will have the following 4 themes for monitoring:

1. Major Central Sector, Centrally Sponsored Schemes & State Schemes with Key Performance Indicators (KPI)
2. Major Central & State Infrastructure Projects
3. Achievements under Viksit Odisha 2036 & 2047
4. Industrial Project Monitoring

B. Action to be taken by Departments

1. **SCHEMES**

The data of major schemes of the Department should be available on the dashboard ideally through APIs. The present position of schemes providing data through APIs is at Annexure-I and that through updation in MS Excel is at Annexure-II.

- a. Departments providing data through excel uploads should move towards providing data through APIs. Till that is done, the data through excel should be updated on a weekly/ fortnightly basis by the concerned Nodal Officer of the Department.
- b. New schemes have been started since the last year like Subhadra, Shaheed Madho Singh Haath Kharcha Yojana etc. These should find reflection in the portal (illustrative list at Annexure-III)
- c. KPIs should be finalised for easy monitoring and measuring performance.

**[Action: All Departments to review and appoint Nodal Officers and to ensure the above by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025]**

## 2. MAJOR PROJECTS

All major projects i.e. both Central and State Government will be entered in the PMG portal and monitored through the same.

- a. State Government projects of Works, Water Resources, Steel and Mines, Energy, Tourism, Energy etc. should be entered in the PMG portal for which the "State" window has been activated.
- b. A Data Visualization dashboard is being developed which will enable District Collectors & Heads of the Department to view pending projects and issues pertaining to their departments.
- c. A separate letter is being issued regarding updation of data on PMG portal and regular review by District Collectors/ Departments.

**[Action: IPICOL will be the nodal agency for PRAGATI as well as PMG Projects (Central and State). A dedicated Cell led by the Managing Director, IPICOL is to be setup in IPICOL for coordination and monitoring of the Infrastructure Projects]**

## 3. VIKSIT ODISHA 2036 and 2047

- a. **KPI Finalization and Upload:** Based on the Vision Odisha 2036 and 2047 strategic documents, Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) for each Department will be finalized and integrated into the Dashboard.
- b. **Real-Time Data Upload:** Departments are required to upload KPI-related data in real time, enabling continuous monitoring and assessment of progress towards the vision goals.

**[Action: All Departments to finalize the KPIs in coordination with the Strategic Support Unit (SSU) of the Office of Chief Secretary by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025]**

#### **4. INDUSTRIAL PROJECTS**

- a. **End-to-End Monitoring:** The Dashboard will track industrial projects throughout all phases—from MoU signing, project development stages, commencement of commercial operations, to incentive disbursal.
- b. **GoSWIFT Portal as Single-Window System:** The GoSWIFT Portal will function as the singular single-window clearance system facilitating project proponents to secure all necessary permissions, licenses, and clearances seamlessly through one portal, replacing the need for multiple portals as per the Guidebook for Single Window System for States issued by DPIIT, Government of India in May 2025.

**[Action: IPICOL will be the Nodal Agency for the Industrial Projects module. All relevant Departments should integrate their systems with GoSWIFT by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025]**

#### **Nodal Agency for Development and Support**


The Odisha Computer Application Centre (OCAC) has been designated as the Nodal Agency responsible for the development, maintenance, and technical support of the Dashboard. All Departments are requested to coordinate closely with OCAC for timely API integration, data migration, and any technical assistance required for successful implementation of the Dashboard.

## Implementation and Compliance

- a. All Secretaries are requested to ensure immediate coordination with their respective Departments and OCAC to facilitate seamless integration of their schemes, projects, and KPIs with the Chief Minister's Dashboard.
- b. Compliance will be monitored periodically, and Departments are expected to adhere strictly to the timelines and data accuracy standards.
- c. The dashboard will be launched by 1<sup>st</sup> October 2025.

Your cooperation and prompt action in this matter will significantly contribute to the Government's objective of enhancing transparency, accountability, and efficient service delivery for the citizens of Odisha.
